ENTRY FORM

Please enter my yacht:.....for the races marked on the Entry Schedule and for such other races in 2011 as I advise.

I agree to abide by the International Sailing Federation Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the RYA prescriptions thereto, the IRC Rules, Parts A, B & D (Advertising not permitted) and the General Conditions of JOG.

I declare that the name of the yacht does not promote/advertise a commercial enterprise.

I acknowledge that it is my sole responsibility to ensure compliance with the following:

(a) A boat is entirely responsible for her own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing, whether in the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility.

(b) It is for the boat to decide whether she is fit to sail in the conditions in which she will find herself. By going to sea the boat confirms that she is fit for those conditions and her crew is competent to sail and compete in them.

(c) The boat is required to hold adequate insurance and in particular to hold insurance against third party claims.

(d) Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the boat nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the race and the event, and include the organising authority, the race committee, the race officer and the starting and finishing officials.

(e) The provision of patrol boats do not relieve the boat of her responsibilities.

(f) The boat is responsible to ensure that she is equipped and seaworthy so as to be able to face extremes of weather; that there is a crew sufficient in number, experience and fitness to withstand such weather; and that the safety equipment is properly maintained, stowed and in date and that the crew know how to use it.

(g) The fact that the race committee conducts inspections of a boat does not reduce the responsibilities of the boat set out in this form.

I have read the Notice of Race and confirm that I agree to its provisions and that my boat will conform to its requirements throughout the event.
